

## **GET CRAFTY:**HOMEMADE PINECONE BIRDFEER



Pinecone feeders are a classic DIY bird feeder option because they are easy to do and offer a lot of room to adapt them to your preferences. Whether you're five or fifty, these pinecone bird feeders are sure to bring a smile to your face!

## Materials Needed

- Pinecones
- Peanut Butter
- Birdseed

- Yarn or Twine
- Cornmeal
- Nuts (optional)

- Berries (optional)
- Unsweetened cereal (optional)

## Instructions

- 1. Start by collecting some of the pinecones scattered around your yard the bigger the better!
- 2. Then, tie some yarn, twine, or string to the top of each pinecone.
- 3. Scoop a dollop of peanut butter and smear it on the pinecone. Make sure to cover the entire surface and push some into the cracks.
- 4. Roll the peanut butter-covered pinecone in birdseed and cornmeal, coating completely.
- 5. Feel free to add nuts, berries, and unsweetened cereal to your pinecones depending on what birds you'd like to attract!
- 6. Hang them around your yard as edible ornaments for the birds.
