



GET CRAFTY: POPCORN STRANDS



You know those strands of popcorn some people use to decorate their trees indoors? Well, try hanging them outside and let the birds have a feast! It's a great activity to do with kids, and once you're done, you can all sit back and enjoy watching the birds together.

Materials Needed

- ◆ Unsalted, unbuttered popcorn
- ◆ Cranberries (optional)
- ◆ String or wire
- ◆ Needle

Instructions

1. Pop your unsalted, unbuttered popcorn in the microwave, on the stovetop, or in an air popper.
2. Begin threading your popcorn with a needle and some string to form a garland.
 - ◆ Alternately, you can use flexible wire to form your popcorn creation into a particular shape. First, form your wire into a design. Then thread the popcorn – no needle required for this!
3. If you're feeling festive, you can also add some cranberries to the mix!
4. Tie off the ends of your garland. If using wires, make sure sharp ends are covered or secured.
5. Hang or drape the finished popcorn treats on trees, or anywhere around your yard. Enjoy!
