



GET CRAFTY: WINTER SUET WREATH



Suet is a great treat for birds in winter when other food sources are scarce. Kick your snack time offerings up a notch by turning your suet treats into a festive wreath decoration! It's a great holiday activity and the birds will certainly appreciate your efforts.

Materials Needed

- Bundt pan
- Wide ribbon
- 3 blocks rendered suet
- ½ cup of peanut butter
- 9 cups of bird seed
- Dried fruits and berries

Instructions

1. Over low heat, melt your suet in a large pot, stirring consistently to ensure it does not boil.
2. Next, add the peanut butter to the pot and let the mixture melt and blend. Remove the pot from heat.
3. Combine the liquid suet mixture with the bird seed.
4. Spray the Bundt pan with plenty of cooking spray. Fill the bottom of the pan with berries and fruit.
5. Fill the Bundt pan with your liquid suet and seed mixture. Let it sit in the refrigerator or other cool place overnight so it can set. Once hardened, carefully remove it from the pan.
6. Tie your festive ribbon around the "wreath" to hang it outside for the birds to enjoy.
